### **Lights, camera, action... in Brisbane's Queen Street Mall**

The Queen Street Mall's central performance space has revolutionised live entertainment in the heart of Brisbane.

#### **Queen Street Mall Stage**

- The stage in the Queen Street Mall features a stunning 11 metre high sky-roof and is located between George and Albert Streets outside The Myer Centre and the Queen Adelaide Building.
- The stage is fitted with high quality lighting and audio systems that can accommodate the technical requirements of most performances.
- The stage also doubles as a civic area with the actual performance platform not much higher than the surrounding pedestrian surface. This ensures the locations do not create visual barriers and allows both areas to function as people places with full wheelchair access when the stages are not in use.
- The stage is provided FREE of charge for use by community groups and Queen Street Mall retailers. A dedicated staff of experienced Stage Managers ensures every mall performance is professional and seamless.
- Brisbane Marketing showcases over 500 FREE live events per year in the Queen Street Mall.
- A variety of high profile international and national performers have performed on stage including Scissor Sisters, Delta Goodrem, Guy Sebastian, Alex Loyd, End of Fashion and Westlife, as well as appearances from a number of high profile sporting teams.
- In 2008 Brisbane Marketing launched a FREE school holiday program called QSM Kids. QSM Kids ensures the little ones are always entertained during the holiday periods.
- The Queen Street Mall showcases a hi-quality sound and lighting system that runs the entire length of the mall.
- The mall has been equipped with multi-zoned music, effects and paging network of 70 self-amplified speakers that can distribute sound in a multitude of patterns, forms and layers in a way similar to that of a cinematic surround-sound system.
- As part of QSM Live, experience the Queen Street Mall come to life on Friday nights and throughout the weekend and get your fix of local music talent all for free. Brisbane's up-and-coming artists are presented both on stage and in informal installations throughout the Queen Street Mall, stretching into Reddacliff Place.
- During Christmas the Queen Street Mall comes alive with a series of blue LED Christmas light decorations, which glow at night and shimmer by daylight.
